As you will know, the year 6 residential visit to Kingswood residential will be from **Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2019**, which is the final week of the Spring term before the Easter break. We have selected a varied activity programme which includes abseiling, archery, climbing and many more activities all led by specialist instructors.

The visit will take place at the Kingswood Activity Centre, West Runton, Norfolk. ([www.kingswood.co.uk](http://www.kingswood.co.uk)). The courses are designed to meet the needs of individual schools and the centre is used to children of mixed ages and abilities. Accommodation is in centrally heated dormitories sleeping 4-16 children in bunk beds. The children will receive three hot meals a day and all specialist equipment will be provided.

We are enclosing the kit list so that you have the opportunity to start preparing over half term. As the weather in April is changeable, we have included both winter and warmer weather options.

### Kit List

Bath towel x 1  
Toiletries

Nightclothes  
Indoor shoes/slipper socks  
Long socks and underwear – plus spares!  
Extra socks (no trainer socks)  
T-shirts including long sleeved ones  
Thick/warm jumpers and sweatshirts  
Jogging trousers (jeans are only suitable to travel in)

Waterproof jacket and trousers and spares for caving  
Walking boots, wellies and thick socks  
Shoes suitable for walking in and 1 pair of old trainers  
3 or 4 pairs of gloves (2 pairs must be thick, warm gloves), hat and scarf  
Clothes for disco  
Sun cream  
Sun hat

Large plastic bag for dirty clothes  
Disposable/cheap digital camera (this will be the child's responsibility)  
Cuddly toy (essential)  
Lip balm/Vaseline for chapped lips.

Please do not bring

Mobile phones  
Electronic games or personal stereos  
Expensive clothes  
Sweets/biscuits/snacks  
Hair dryers/straighteners

Please remember

1. Clothes may be getting muddy and wet so it is important to have plenty of old, warm clothes to change into, when necessary.
